### Mosquito Spraying

Approved at the August 2014 LIS Meeting, this year's spraying service will be provided by Mosquito Squad and will automatically INCLUDE TWO TREATMENTS per your location in late June and late July. The majority felt that one treatment per season is not effective and we were able to solidify a great deal for two treatments per household, a good savings over last year's price. The Barrier Spray will be applied around the exterior of your home and throughout your yard to target not only mosquitoes, but ticks, flies, fleas and other biting bugs. The LIS will also be paying for treatment in the beach area.

Single Lot Treatment - \$99.00

Double Lot Treatment - \$179.00

Triple Lot Treatment - \$249.00
